## Tire Rack Scholarship



Recipients of this scholarship shall be known as TIRE RACK SCHOLARS

To become a scholar, you must complete and submit the Online Scholarship Application (OSA) General Application. Once submitted, you must apply for the IUSB-Tire Rack Scholars by **July 18, 2025.** **change date to March 1, 2026**

**Minimum Eligibility:** Students seeking an undergraduate degree, be enrolled full-time.

**Amount:** Based on published in-state tuition and required fees. Amount will vary by student.

**Renewal:** May be renewed up to 3 additional years (exceptions apply), if enrolled full-time and have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher.
